Paul spoke about the area from Taree to Newcastle and commented on the railway down to the Hawkesbury before the bridge was constructed.

Paul was commissioned to undertake an archeological survey of Hearts Point and encompassed the timber mill village. He provided an insight into the discoveries made, the water front, the barges that have survived in the lake and the buildings and equipment utilised in the logging industry.

Here are the steps:

- 1. Open a webpage in Microsoft Edge.

- 4. When the captured webpage appears, click SAVE (top right corner) and the image will then be stored in your DOWNLOADS folder.
